What is TCC ?

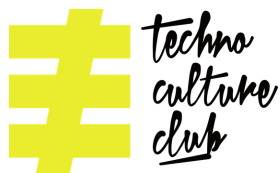
Techno Culture Club is a nonprofit organization that promotes and supports digital literacy and digital justice in order to make technology and digital culture more accessible, equitable and participative.
